Role Description: Bounty & Soul is seeking a Latinx Engagement intern to expand and implement resources and programs to meet the varied needs of the Latino and Hispanic population in Buncombe and McDowell Counties. Primary roles will include translating recipes, translating cooking demonstrations at our three weekly mobile markets, and collaborating with partner agencies to expand the quality of our services.

Schedule: Flexible

Hours: A minimum of 90 hours, but preferably 120+ hours for the semester; Between 7-10 hours per week

Direct Report: Program Assistant/Coordinator

Responsibilities:

- Translate recipes, Nourishment Guides and other resources into Spanish
- Welcome Spanish-speaking participants at our pop-up market for the Sherwood Mobile Home Park on Wednesday afternoons, and assist with tally, inside the truck responsibilities, cooking demonstrations and announcements in Spanish
- Support the development and implementation of the Alan Campos pre-made produce box deliveries on Thursday afternoons
- Assist in the design and posting of social media content for Zumba classes, weekly markets and other Bounty & Soul promotional needs as they arise
- Continue building relationships with Sherwood residents, Alan Campos residents, MANNA FoodBank, YMCA, United Way 211 and other community members and partner agencies to implement additional resources and improve the quality of existing resources
- Collaborate with Health & Wellness interns to create Nutrition Information cards for various produce and healthy food staples to be available at all mobile market distributions.
- Assist with the planning and coordination of the potential launch of a new market in Alan Campos specifically for the Latino community
- Willingness to contribute to the needs of the organization as may arise
